The CEC also actively engages with the community and caters for local and regional market needs by providing high-quality customized and professional training programs.

Academic Advising

As part of its dedication to academic success, USTF is committed to offering high quality academic advising in order to help students in the development and pursuit of academic objectives consistent with their life goals. Academic advising is an ongoing process that connects students to the University to empower each student with knowledge, resources and skills that will lead to academic success and lifelong desire to learn inside and outside the classroom.

USTF advising policy postulates that:

- All students shall be informed of the advising policy and advising process during the initial orientation and be directed to an appropriate advisor;
- All students shall be assigned advisors;
- All students on probation must be given regular advising each semester;
- All students expected to graduate must be advised at least twice every semester of their final year;
- Career counseling and student counseling shall be made available to all students;
- Advising by faculty members for all new and continuing students shall be provided every semester;
- Assessment of department advising shall be carried out every semester as a part of the whole program assessment;
- Academic department advising shall be assessed and reviewed every year;
- Funding and resources shall be made available to all units to ensure effective and efficient advising at all levels; Training shall be provided for all advisors and peer mentors;
- Accurate information shall be posted and maintained on the University website.

The goals of academic advising are to:

- Help students take the right decisions in choosing an appropriate course of study that is aligned with their interests, abilities and that meets their academic and life objectives;
- Answer questions raised by students and to ensure that students are aware of the consequences of their choices;
- Ensure that all students are aware of resources, services and educational opportunities at USTF that may be pertinent to the student's educational goals;
- Provide information on university policies and procedures;
- Facilitate the resolution of academic problems, conflicts and concerns, as appropriate;
- Refer students, as necessary, to other resources/ departments/personnel;
- Encourage students to be creative in their academic choices;
- Provide a forum for interaction and guidance about life and academic matters;
- Collect data about students' needs, expectations and aspirations.

The Acting Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs (AVCAA) is the principal provider of academic leadership for all Colleges of the University, and all of the support Deanships, Offices and Service Units within USTF's Organization Structure that support the academic mission of the University.

The AVCAA is responsible for developing a performance culture that promotes excellence in teaching and learning, research and scholarly activities, innovation and new learning technologies. He ensures excellence in teaching and learning and providing cutting-edge services and operations to USTF stakeholders. In addition, this position is aligned with best practices of good governance in academic institutions. The AVCAA leads the University in its academic planning and in the setting of academic values, policies and practices. One of the core responsibilities of AVCAA is promoting educational programs and related activities on campus and building internal and external relationships with the ultimate goal of significantly increasing the community involvement and securing support for the University. The AVCAA is responsible for developing a performance culture that promotes University's objectives, program innovation, new learning technologies and teaching excellence and stimulating a high level of scholarly productivity. The AVCAA oversees the administrative practices associated with enrollment, course offerings, tuition, student fees, and the policies and values that guide these endeavors.

USTF AVCAA oversees colleges, Deanship of Graduate Studies and Research, Deanship of Student Affairs, Office of Admission and Registration, Office of Career Counseling, Office of Alumni, Library and Learning Resources, Student Housing, Training Center, Continuing Education Center and Office of International Academic Affairs.

The Vice Chancellor for Administrative and Financial Affairs (VCAFA) serves as a strategic advisor to the chancellor and recommends financial objectives, policies, programs and practices that ensure a sound financial structure for the University. The VCAFA in support of the mission and goals of the University oversees the development of policies, programs and practices that will ensure a sound administrative structure, and is responsible for developing a long-term sustainable economic model, which ensures the viability of the University.

The Board of Trustees was established in accordance with Resolution No. 10 of 2018 issued by His Highness Sheikh Hamad bin Mohammed Al Sharqi, Member of the Supreme Council and Ruler of Fujairah. The Board consists of HE Saeed bin Mohammed Al Raqbani – Advisor to His Highness Ruler of Fujairah, Chairman of Fujairah Charity Association Board of

Trustees, HE Mr. Osama Saeed Salmar, HE Ali Mubarak Bin Abad Al Abdooli, Dr. Ahmed Al-Khuzaimi, Ms. Aisha Ahmed Al-Yamahi, and Prof. Farouk Hamada. The meeting was devoted to discuss the tasks and developments arising from the launch of the University and its adoption as a new independent university which is an important addition to the higher education process in the Emirate and the Country. It is worthy to mention that upon the arrival of His Highness the Crown Prince of Fujairah to the University, HE was welcomed by the members of the Board of Trustees, the University's Chancellor Prof. Ali Abu Al-Nour, faculty members, and administrative staff.

Participation in URC 2019 Conference

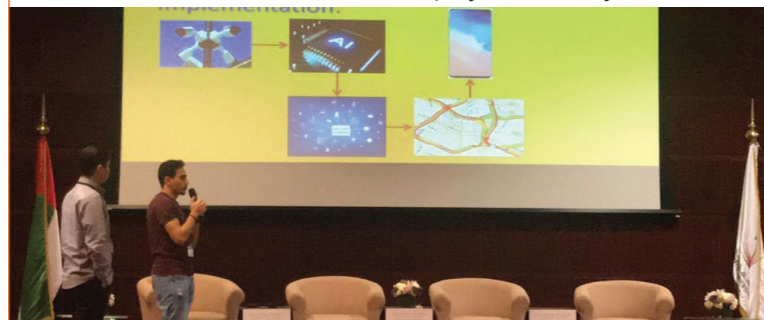
