The Red Crescent Authority has prepared its comprehensive health campaign at Dibba Exhibition Center for the period 4-6 November 2021. Within the framework of the existing cooperation between the Emirates Red Crescent and the University of Science and Technology of Fujairah for the success of charitable work and under the guidance of Professor Dr. Ali Abou Elnour, Director of the University, the College of Pharmacy and the College of Dentistry participated in the comprehensive health campaign during the relevant period.

The participation of the College of Pharmacy under the supervision of Prof. Dr. Sumaya Sir Al-Khatm (Dean of the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences) has resulted in spreading health awareness among visitors by raising awareness of the importance of medicinal plants and their therapeutic



role in an attempt to reduce the use of medicines and their side effects. The participation was also accompanied by public awareness of antibiotic resistance and its impact on weakening immunity in the future when treating and that the use of antibiotics should be under full medical supervision.

Orientation session for new students
The University of Science and Technology of Fujairah (USTF) held an orientation session for new students enrolled in the second semester of the academic year 2021/2022 in a face-to-face ceremony in the conference hall of the University of Science and Technology of Fujairah.

The ceremony was attended by His Excellency Prof. Ali Abouelnour – USTF Chancellor, and Prof. Zein Elabidin Rizk – Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, and Dr. Ahmed Zain Elabdin – Vice Chancellor for Administrative and Financial Affairs, and Dr. Sameh Khamis - Director of the Office of Admissions and Registration, in addition to representatives of student services at the university.

The ceremony began with the national anthem of the United Arab Emirates and verses of the Holy Quran, then an introductory video was shown about the university's facilities and the distinguished university life provided to the students. - Agreement with institutions to offer discounts such as Faza'a-Saada-Esaad-Waffer discount cards.

- Providing discounts for the children and relatives of the martyrs

The general objectives of the Public Relations Department of the Sharjah Ladies Club, and we will mention them:

- Providing the opportunity for private institutions to appear by promoting the services and products of the institutions on special occasions, distributing their products as gifts to the public and is considered a sponsorship by the private institution.
- Social participation with influencers in the region by sending gifts.
- Attracting international brands and allocating an open day for each brand to display their products and promote themselves.
- Linking institutions to society through community partnerships.

Nature of management work:

- Coordination of tournaments and sporting events held in the city of Kalba. Announcing these events to the public using social media.
- Find sponsors for tournaments and events.
- Diversifying sporting events to attract and attract the largest segment of society.
- Educational campaigns and awareness of the importance of sport in the life of the individual and the preservation of health.
- Attracting talented children and youth athletes of all ages to participate in the club.
- Assisting in achieving goals and focusing on the future vision of the club.

Communication with the authorities:

The Institutional Support and Public Relations Department communicates formally with the institutions by e-mail and holds weekly meetings at the club's headquarters, to provide security, health aid and other organizing bodies on the dates of the matches that are presented at the beginning of each week.

Media production:

- (Internally) The department makes health awareness publications to maintain the health of the players as well as proper nutrition, what they



must do in case of sports injuries First Aid, and how to prepare for matches psychologically and physically.

- (Externally) The department distributes leaflets to introduce the available games that the club offers to the community, including (chess, karate, taekwondo, volleyball, basketball, handball, football, running, and futsal).

Event Planning Mechanism:

- Send an email to the concerned authorities and organizations to publicize the event.
- Conducting a coordination meeting between the authorities and selecting and inspecting the appropriate location for the event.
- Communicate with the Social Services Department to provide volunteers.
- Searching for event sponsors to provide prizes and additional activities and reduce the total cost of the event.
- Ensure that all needs of the public are provided at the venue of the sporting event (mobile restaurants, first aid, security, etc.)
- Example: the event that was held on Kalba Beach, "Kalba Beach Games" - where the presidents of the federation were called for every beach sport in the UAE to be sponsors of sports, and former and well-known athletes in the city of Kalba were also invited to market for this event, choosing the appropriate location, which was overlooking the street. The main and close to the residential neighborhoods to attract the public, the provision of many parking lots, the availability of a mosque near the site of the event for prayer, as

well as the provision of patrons from restaurants to provide a variety of foods to the public and a special place for children to play.

Cooperation and services provided by the department to the community:

Attorney General of the College Public Prosecution, who explained many of the procedural rules related to the investigation of the criminal case in crimes, whether they are misdemeanors or felonies that the Public Prosecution takes after referring the file of the criminal case from the judicial police, showing how the interrogation of the accused and deciding whether the matter requires his release or pretrial detention pending investigation and within the time limit granted by law to the Public Prosecution, and investigation procedures in other evidence He briefed the students on the difficulties facing the investigator

and how to overcoming it, and the importance of preserving the crime scene from tampering, as in many of the cases he faced in his work investigating criminal cases, the crime scene and the material effects of the offender are the reliable procedure for convicting or acquitting the accused, particularly when no further evidence is available. He noted that the role of the prosecutor was not limited to the impunity of the perpetrator, but also to protect the innocent and support the oppressed, and that decision-making in some important cases needed to be consulted and presented to the Technical Office of the Attorney-General for polling.

Tuesday, Mar 22, 2022


