The College of Business Administration at the University of Science and Technology of Fujairah organized a Webinar on the topic of international management and cross-cultural business skills presented by Dr Alberto Ibanez, the college faculty member.

At the beginning of the Webinar, Dr Ahmed Zain Elabdin, Vice Chancellor for Administrative and Financial Affairs, conveyed to the attendees the greetings of the University Chancellor, Prof. Ali Abu Al-Nour and his interest in such

The College of Business Administration at the University of Science and Technology of Fujairah, in cooperation with the UAE Securities and Commodities Authority, organized a webinar entitled «The Impact of the Covid-19 Pandemic on Business and Economic expectations in the GCC countries». Dr Ahmed Zain Elabdin, Dean of the College of Business Administration, spoke at its beginning. Explaining the importance of such webinars, which the college continued to hold continuously to enrich academic and professional controversies and based on the university's vision of interacting with the business community and adopting constructive ideas.

This webinar session comes as an integral part of enhancing theoretical

knowledge, which solidifies information in students' minds and provides them with the necessary skills at the core of the educational process, which leads to better learning.

Ms Soha Ragab, a financial markets expert at the Securities and Commodities Authority, gave the keynote lecture on the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on business and economic expectations in the global economy and the focus on the economies of the GCC countries and the UAE.

The Webinar discussed the pandemic's impact on the various economic sectors and the winners and losers. Ms Soha emphasized that international institutions have begun to adjust their expectations by decreasing in different rates for economic growth and various economic sectors' performance globally.

As the pandemic caused severe fluctuation in stock indices in the leading stock exchanges and many travel sectors, tourism, consumer product prices, and a drop in oil prices by about 9 per cent, moving prices to a range of 40-50 dollars per barrel.

On the other hand, technology, Online platforms, and e-commerce companies emerged from the crisis with massive gains and revenues. They benefited from the increase in the use of technology in individuals' daily lives and the reliance on a large segment of consumers on e-commerce platforms, which contributed to enhancing these companies' profits and profits.

The webinar dealt with the significant shifts in the business sector and the economy, which prompted decision-makers to rethink the used economic and trade theories. Considering the defects of the supply chain dependent on abroad, companies consider looking for local alternatives. As globalization accelerates to decline, the old developmental economic theories that encourage developing economies to shift themselves away from exports and domestic markets are likely to return.

The webinar discussed the tremendous positive impact of government intervention in GCC Countries in the economic process to face periods of recession and the potential for a downturn due to the pandemic. Their financial and monetary

powers used many decisions taken that effectively contributed to their countries' economic stimulation.

Finally, at the end of the webinar, discussed how the business and economy's future would look like after the pandemic and its impact on

work performance methods, as «Work Remotely» may be the «new normal» for many employees and managers. Also, significant companies are thinking seriously about permanently moving to «Work Remotely» and reducing office space. Likely, companies will now review - and lower - the multi-step and multi-country supply chains that dominate today's production and advances in robotics, automation, and 3D printing. CBA faculty members attended the webinar, and students and showed significant interaction during it.

The symposium on protecting the right to privacy

Monday, Mar 22, 2021

The College of Law at the University of Science and Technology in Fujairah held a symposium on the subject of protecting the right to privacy on Monday 3/25/2021, at 6:30 pm remotely via Microsoft Teams technology, as part of its plans to spread legal awareness on issues of concern among community members. Prof. Dr. Khalaf Muhammad and Dr. Amin Dahmash, a member of the faculty, spoke about it. The event was moderated by the Honorable Dr. Inas Al-Khalidi, and it was attended by students studying at the college, graduates from it, and many interested in the legal field.

Prof. Dr. Khalaf Muhammad presented the protection of the right to privacy in Islamic law, and explained the Sharia rules that guaranteed protection for the privacy of individuals in the Holy Qur'an, in the Prophet's Sunnah and in

the jurisprudence of the jurists. He referred to the hadith of the Messenger of God, may God's prayers and peace be upon him, who said that "It is good for a person to leave Islam for something that does not mean it." It is not permissible to transmit news that distorts the reputation of others, or breaches their secrets, or intrudes upon them by snooping, espionage, or infringing on the sanctities of their homes.

Dr. Amin Dahmash then spoke about the legal protection of the right to privacy, and referred to global and regional international conventions that affirmed that "No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference in his private life, family affairs, housing, or correspondence, nor to campaigns affecting his honor and reputation, and every person has the right to be subjected to arbitrary interference in his private life, family affairs, housing, or correspondence. The law protects him from such interference or attacks." He explained that the Emirati legislator emphasized the importance of the right to privacy and the need to protect it, and enshrined this protection in the constitution within the public rights and freedoms established for citizens, as well as many legal texts that provide civil and criminal protection for the right to privacy from infringement by traditional means such as publishing in newspapers and magazines. And various media outlets; or by means of modern technology and communication technology, by criminalizing the violation of privacy and facing it with deterrent penalties.

During the symposium, many interventions were presented by the attendees and many questions were discussed and answered, and many of the attendees preferred this step that deepens the legal culture and strengthens Communication between the college and its graduate students and those working in legal fields in government and private departments.

As part of its continuous efforts to consolidate its relations with governmental and private community institutions, and to enhance communication with partners to achieve its societal responsibility, and within the framework of the policy pursued by the University of Science & Technology of Fujairah in its vision and interaction with the community, and to provide students with experience and knowledge through direct contact and linking the theoretical aspect to the field reality.

Students of the Department of Sociology and Social Work studying the Social Work and Social Defense course, under the supervision of Dr. Asmaa Ahmed, made a virtual visit to the Department of the Most Vulnerable Groups of the Community Development Authority in Dubai on Thursday the 22nd of April 2021. The visit aimed to introduce students to the professional role of social workers in caring for the most vulnerable groups. This is by getting to know the services and programs provided by the Dubai Community Development Authority to take care of the inmates of penal and correctional institutions and their families, and the care and rehabilitation of addicts recovering from addiction, and the programs provided to satisfy the needs and face the social problems associated with these groups.

The visit started with an introductory video about the various services and programs provided by the Community Development Authority in Dubai, then the meeting was initiated by Dr. Hoda Al Suwaidi, Director of the Department of the Most Vulnerable Groups, who gave a presentation in which she spoke about the most important programs, services and initiatives provided by the Department of the most vulnerable groups to take care of the inmates of penal and correctional institutions And the released and their families, which include counseling programs, support services, psychological, social and material support, and help inmates and released detainees to overcome any difficulties or problems that prevent them from adapting to society. She also emphasized that the success of these programs depends greatly on the role of the family, how cooperative they are and effective participation in providing support and assistance to its families and helping them to adhere to the implementation of these plans and programs in an optimal manner. For these groups, what helps their integration and empowerment in society.

Then Mr. Badr Al Hosani made a presentation in which he included the services and programs that are provided for the care and rehabilitation of addicts through the Aounak (your Help) Center for Social Rehabilitation for those recovering from addiction and at risk of addiction, and the services provided by the center aimed at raising awareness among groups of society in general and the youth group in particular about means of preventing the dangers of drug addiction.

He also talked about the center's role in rehabilitating those recovering from addiction abuse through treatment and rehabilitation programs based on scientific foundations with a focus on providing psychological and social support to them, as well as stressing the importance of aftercare programs to protect recovered people from the risk of relapse and return to abuse and addiction again. A set of training programs are initiated to develop the psychological and social skills of the recovered, in addition to periodic follow-up to help them face any challenges, to ensure that they do not relapse again.

After that, the door was opened for discussion and response to students' inquiries, which were related to practical practices and realistic models for professional interventions with cases.

At the end of the meeting, Dr. Asmaa Ahmed, the visit supervisor, gave a closing speech in which she thanked the work team in charge of organizing and implementing the visit, and stressed the importance of the role of the Community Development Authority in Dubai through its preventive, curative and developmental efforts, and considered it a fundamental supporter for the most vulnerable groups, especially since the efforts done with these groups needs protection from the circumstances and challenges that could spoil them. She also stressed the importance of the professional role of social workers in preparing and designing professional intervention programs through a multidisciplinary team with the aim of raising the level of knowledge, experience and skills needed for these groups and helping them to plan for their future. Dr. Asmaa also emphasized to raise their level of awareness and help them overcome any problems that may hinder their psychological and social compatibility in society.

Report on the scientific field visit to the criminal laboratory in Fujairah

Sunday, Oct 24, 2021

On Wednesday, 20/10/2021, the College of Law at the University of Science and Technology in Fujairah organized a scientific visit for college students to the forensic laboratory and crime scene at the Fujairah Police General Command, under the supervision of Dr. Amin Dahmash, Associate Professor of Criminal Law; This is to inform the college students about how to seize, seize and examine evidence related to the crime, and to take the scientific means to preserve it to prevent tampering with it or changing its features. Major/ Muhammad Ahmad Al-Qaywdi presented the procedures followed to collect evidence from the crime scene, starting with the work of the security cordon, camera and video recording, and then marking and numbering in preparation for capturing and preserving them by scientific means. Captain/ Kholoud Hamad Al-Khalidi, Director of the Criminal Laboratory, talked about the procedures followed in examining physical evidence and employing the latest equipment in analyzing samples taken from drug users to determine the type of drug or psychotropic substance that was used or seized, to see if it was among the narcotic substances listed in the tables attached to the Anti-Narcotics Law Emirati Narcotics and Psychotropic Substances, and the expert in chemical and biological analyzes, Dr. Muhammad Al-Ghazali, presented the scientific methods used to examine chemicals, toxins, explosive materials and the effects of fires, and how to measure the amount of alcohol in the blood and determine the percentage in which a person is considered to be an intoxicant abuser. The presentations included presenting questions from the students present and their responses. Dr. Amin Dahmash and the students present gave thanks and praise to the experts and specialists in crime scenes and the criminal laboratory for these useful scientific presentations and for the generous hospitality and warm reception.
